
### **FEEDBACK ANALYSIS 2020-2021**











5.Relevance of additional source material(Library) 209 responses








2. The course content is relevant to course outcomes 24 responses








## Q5. The college facilitates ICT based teaching




The feedback is designed in a simple manner to elicit the opinion of Alumni with respect to the curriculum they have studied in the institution.

### 2.Usefulness of subject for higher studies




79 percent of alumni felt that the curriculum structure helped them to progress for higher levels of education.

### Q 3. Applicability of Situations











45 per cent of the alumni responded that the course's design is well applicable to real life situations.






91 per cent industrialists expressed their satisfaction over the sufficiency of theoretical background and practical application while 14 per cent recommended measures to improve on the same.


