ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON FEEDBACK - 2020 - 2021

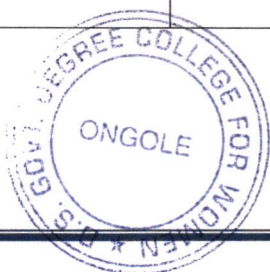
The report provides an overview of the feedback received, the analysis of the feedback taken from stakeholders, and the actions taken to address the concerns raised. The stakeholders include students, faculty members, parents, alumni and employers. Feedback forms have been designed separately for all the stakeholders and was collected through survey. 209 students from different UG programmes, 24 teachers from different departments, 38 alumni and 12 employers gave their feedback on curriculum and academic environment and other student related services in the campus.


The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has analyzed the feedback collected from stakeholders, including students, faculty members, parents and alumni and the following actions were initiated.
