As per the orders of Govt of A.P, permission was accorded by the District Collector Dr N. Jayaprakash Narayana I.A.S to shift the college to the Zillah Parishad building in the year 1986. After construction of own bulding it was shifted to 4th line 11th cross road, Bhagyanagar, Ongole. It isfully equipped with laboratories andICT enabled classrooms and bagged 'B'gradewithaCGPAof2.10 inNAACaccreditation.

The college offers8 UGPrograms.TheCollegehas15departmentswith 467 students on rolls and severalrest uctured andmarket-orientedprogrammes.
