The research policy also emphasizes service to society and the nation as a whole.

Scope

This Research Policy is the basis for the college's research ethics, and it is used by all departments and the college's Research Council to run its business.

Custodian of the Policy

The Director of the Research Council is in charge of implementing and maintaining the research policy. The Research Policy must set up a Research Advisory Cell to help and advise the Principal of the DS Government Degree College for Women, Ongole and the Academic Council on issues related to research in the college.

Objectives of Research Policy

The following are the research policy's primary goals:

1. Raise research awareness among faculty and students of DS Government Degree College for Women in Ongole.
2. To promote an appropriate research culture through various research initiatives and programs.

3. To build a research center in many fields, with a focus on socially relevant themes. Encourage faculty members to write research articles and participate in diverse research projects of social and academic significance.
4. To make a research journal and give faculty, researchers, and academics from the college and all over the country a place to speak.
5. To raise awareness in society through various research activities and by providing adequate publicity to the college's socially beneficial research undertakings

Research Policy

The college must have a clear standard for research quality that scholars, teachers, and everyone else who works there can follow.

1. To encourage original, high-quality basic and applied research in science, literature, commerce, and all related and related fields.
2. Identifying emerging research areas and encouraging faculty members to conduct research in these areas
3. Establish relationships with industry and business groups in order to identify potential study areas, surveys, and other fundamental research inquiries.
4. Obtaining projects, market surveys, and other research operations in order to gain support from other businesses, industries, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), boards, and forums.
5. To encourage academic members to apply for research grants from national funding bodies like SERB, DBT, DST, ICSSR, UGC, and others.
6. Identify faculty members who may serve as research leaders and encourage them to participate in research projects, studies, and surveys.
7. To give financial support for the publication of research papers and findings.
8. To provide a proper forum for DS Government Degree College for Women, Ongole teachers and students to publish their research findings and to encourage them to bring issues of contemporary importance to the attention of society.
9. To hold a variety of workshops to assist scholars and faculty members in developing acceptable research skills.
10. Send faculty members to workshops, symposia, seminars, and conferences in their own fields and in areas that are currently popular.
11. To build the necessary infrastructure in the college to support various research programs.
12. To improve information and data resources for quality research projects and inquiries.
13. To engage in any additional activities that will foster a research culture in the college.
