CERTIFICATE COURSE BY UNXT BY UNNATI

DISTRIBUTION OF ALBENDAZOLE TABLETS



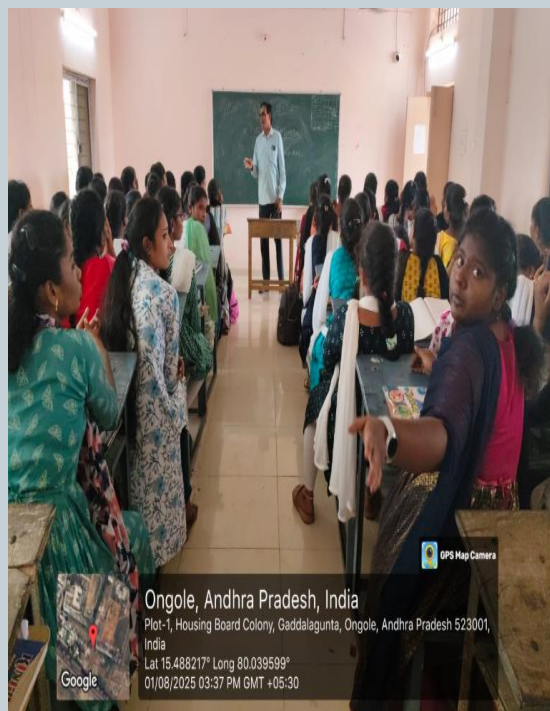

20 నుంచి డిగ్రీ ప్రవేశాల రిజిస్ట్రేషన్లు

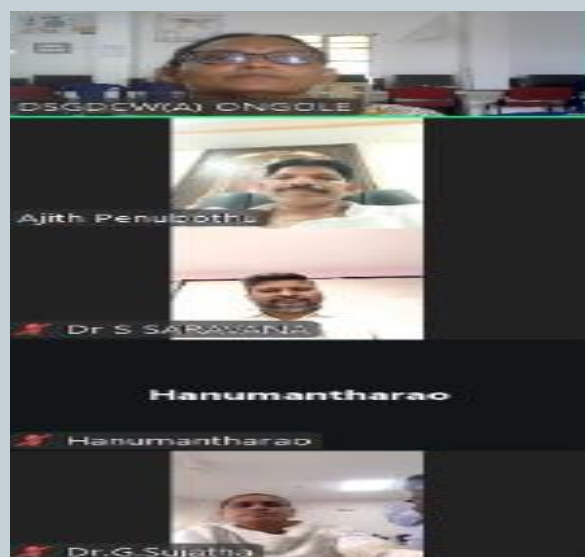
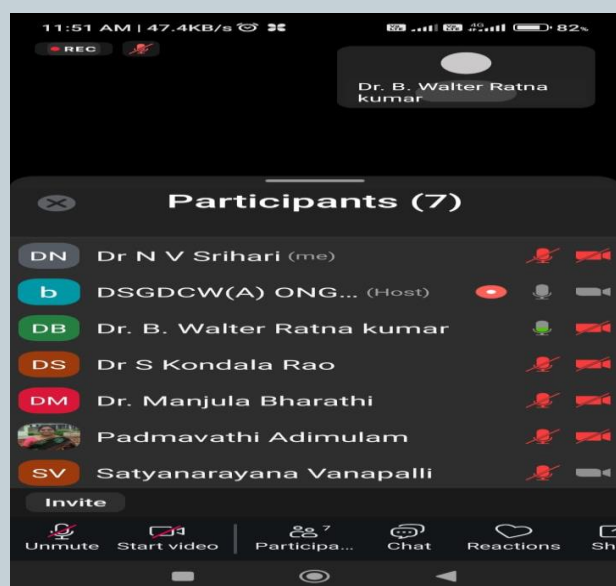
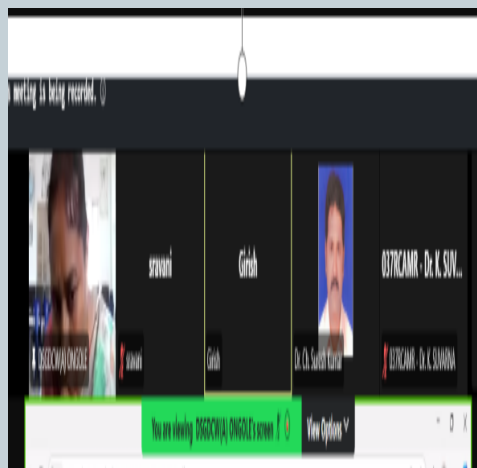

The program concluded with a vote of thanks by the convener of WEC, appreciating the active participation of students and faculty.





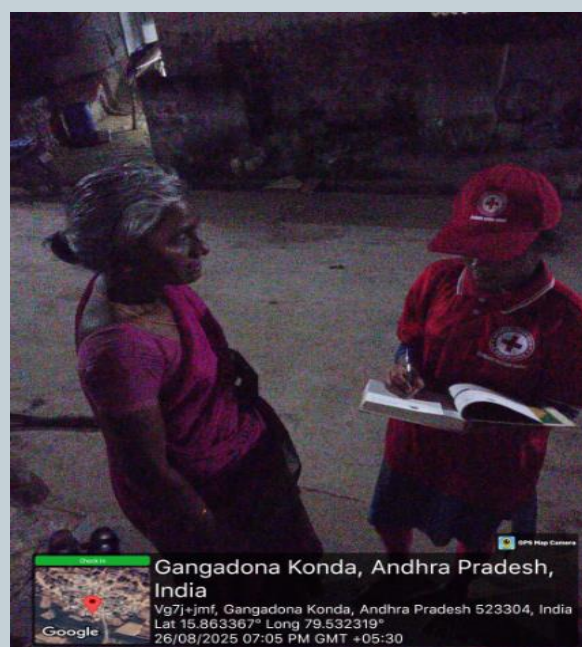
CLIMATE ACTION VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES

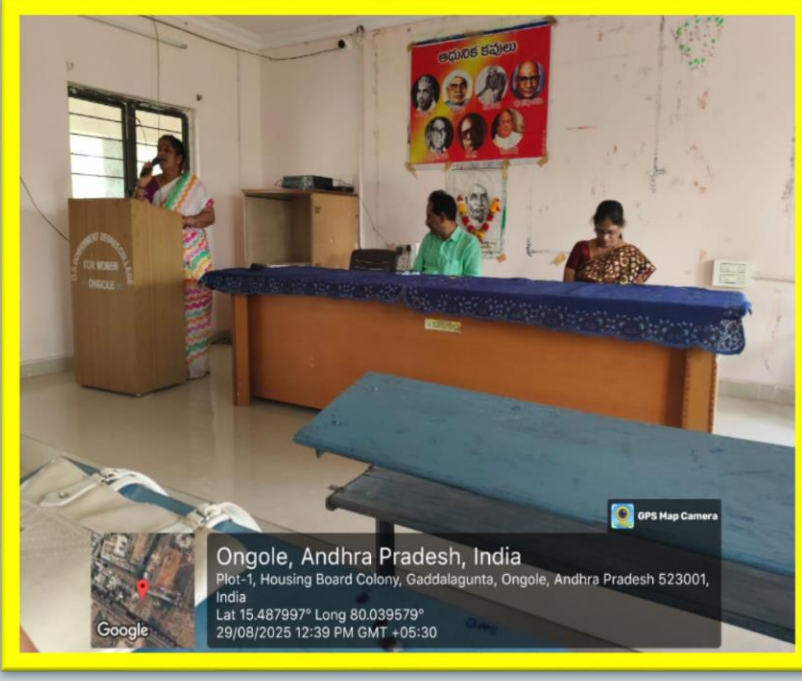
