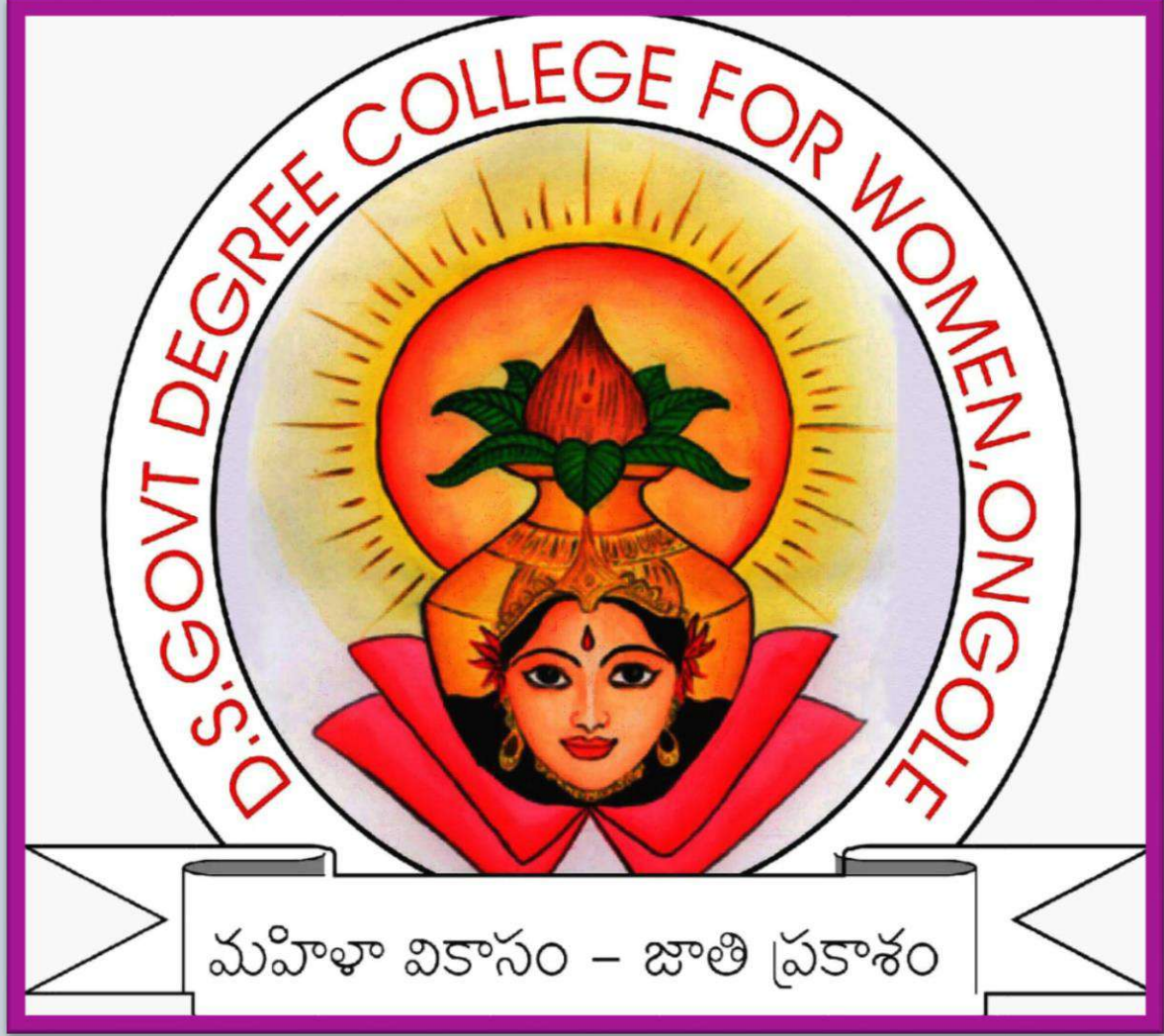

VALEDICTORY FUNCTION- OF CERTIFICATE COURSE BY UNXT UNNATI

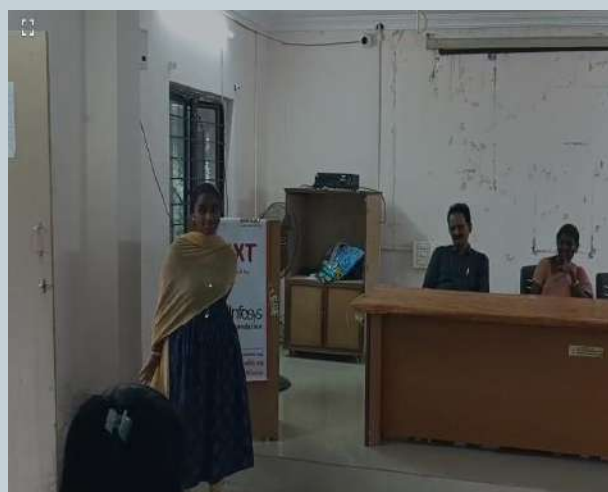
