## GUEST LECTURE IN THE DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER SCIENCE

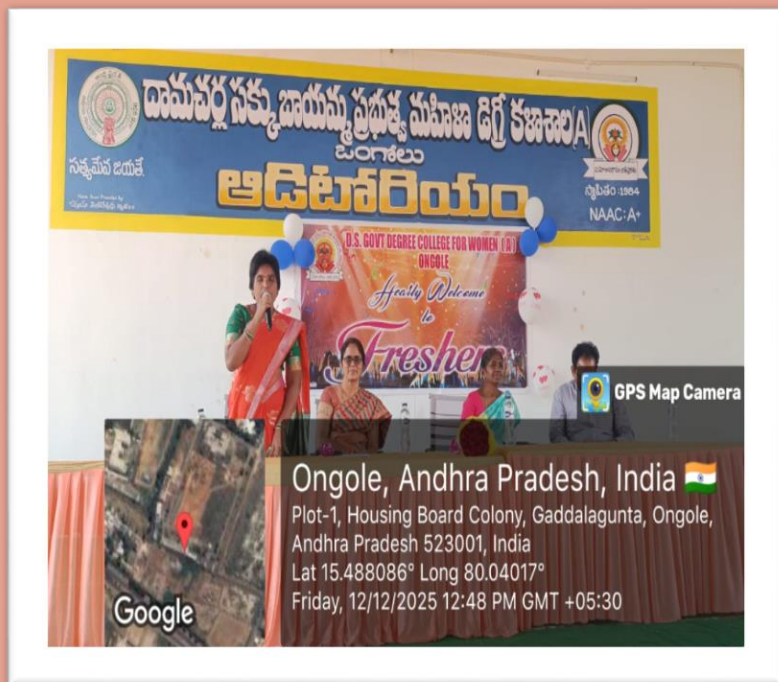

## CELEBRATION OF MATHEMATICS DAY

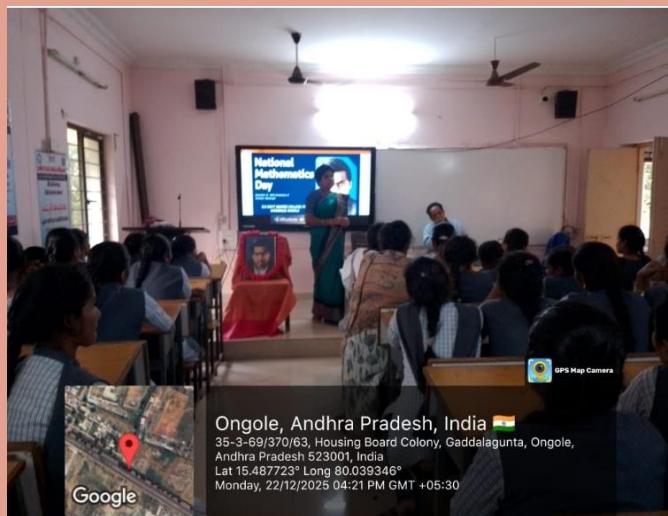

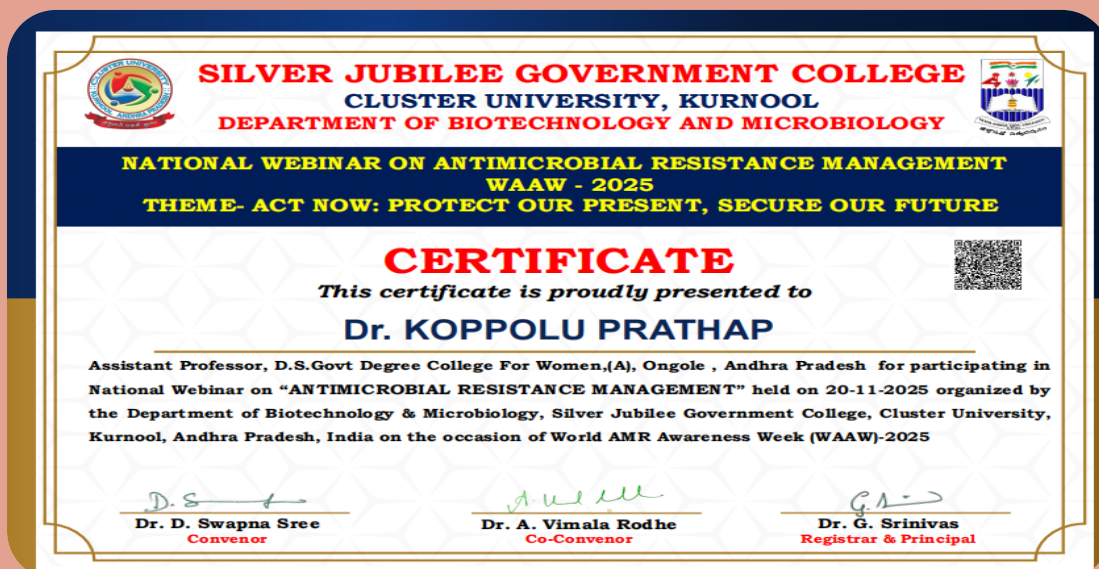
The event began with an address highlighting the historical significance of Veer Bal Divas and the heroic sacrifices made by young warriors for the
